Partnership Between TDSB and the Toronto Scottish Rugby Football Club

Lytton Park Residents' Organization (LPRO) would like to express its support for full and prompt consideration of the proposed partnership between the TDSB and the Toronto Scottish Rugby Football Club (TSRFC).

We understand the purpose of this partnership is to renew the Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute (LPCI) playing field, which would benefit the school, the wider community, and the TSRFC.

LPRO favours optimal health and environmentally-based solutions to the athletic field resurfacing for the use of the LPCI playing field. Our priorities are that:

- Area residents continue to have access to the field and track during times of high demand;
- The artificial turf is of the highest quality in terms of environmental impact, function and safety;
- All turf and all other landscaped areas are maintained using battery-powered equipment for the safety and health of staff, players, and adjacent residents;
- Lawrence Park Collegiate works to transition to pollinator-friendly landscaping and low-maintenance native plant alternatives to turf grass in all other landscaped areas of the site.

This is a wonderful project for the school and the community, and we look forward to seeing it come to fruition.
