Chair Josh Colle and Members of the TTC Board:

On behalf of Lytton Park Residents' Organization ("LPRO"), I write to ask you to include time-based fares among the service improvements you approve at your board meeting on November 28, 2017.

Time-based fares would allow riders using Presto to get off and on the TTC an unlimited number of times within two hours, without any additional cost.

Two-hour fares are good for Toronto transit riders because it would permit riders to get off the TTC on our way home to pick up the kids or buy milk and then get back on again without paying an additional fare. Especially on busy days, we think that a change in this policy would surely encourage citizens to leave their cars and parking problems at home, in favour of a two-hour window with the convenience of jumping on and off the TTC as needed to accomplish those errands. We believe that this would also be good for the TTC because, given a two-hour window, it might persuade a larger proportion of the public to take advantage of the offer, likely boost ridership by supporting folks using the TTC more often, and encourage wider use of Presto cards.

This change in policy would make a real difference and we ask you to strongly consider it.
