### **Special Committee on Governance - Summary of Findings**

#### **Committee Recommendations**

The Special Committee on Governance recommends that:

1. City Council direct the Chief Planner and Executive Director, City Planning to consider partnering with a post-secondary institute to undertake research on the organizational structure of the Committee of Adjustment to better engage and empower residents in the process.
2. City Council direct the City Manager and the City Clerk to identify further opportunities for delegation to Community Council so that City Council can focus on city-wide priorities and that these opportunities be presented to Council by the end of the fourth quarter of 2020.
3. City Council request the City Clerk to report on any changes required to permit the electronic submission of petitions in advance of Council meetings.
4. City Council request the City Clerk to identify opportunities to create a more welcoming atmosphere for public presentations (deputations), including increased information for newcomers, dedicated deputations guides, and posted speaking schedules.
