**TOWN HALL - BATHURST STREET CLOSURE**

You're invited to a town hall at Beth Tzedec Congregation to discuss the proposed closure of Bathurst Street. Come out to discuss the specifics of the closure, the details of work planned within the closure area, and overall progress on Forest Hill Station. The proposal involves a long-term closure of Bathurst Street for one block between Eglinton Avenue West and Wembley Road to accelerate construction of Forest Hill Station. By closing Bathurst Street, the roadway can be restored to normal three months sooner than originally planned.
