Return of the OMB !

Town Hall Meeting hosted by Councillor Mike Colle Re Bill 108, provincial government's Omnibus Bill

The Councillor is holding a Town Hall where you can learn more about this Bill which will make major changes to 13 statutes including the Planning Act, preservation of Heritage buildings, community benefits, and other hard fought protections including the OMB/LPAT. Bill 108 cuts down on timelines for municipal processing of application, limits witness activity in an appeal and restricts third party appeals to sub division planning and proposals. These changes may speed up development but they will benefit developers, and restrict the capacity of individuals to challenge construction. There will be an opportunity for you to ask questions and share your comments.
