City Council Meeting, December 15, 2021
Agenda Item MM38.25 Greater Action to Fight Auto Theft in Toronto

The Lytton Park Residents' Organization ("LPRO") is an incorporated non-profit association, representing residents living in the area bounded by Lawrence Avenue West to Roselawn and Briar Hill Avenues, Yonge Street to Saguenay and Proudfoot Avenue.

We support the recommendations of Councillors Colle and Pasternak's Motion, to request that the Toronto Police Services Board and the Chief of Police determine the resources required to re-establish a policing unit specifically dedicated to fighting the increasing problem of auto theft in Toronto; and to mandate the unit to conduct proactive investigations with partner agencies across Ontario, to ensure greater information sharing and coordination of investigations into high-end auto thefts.

We support their motion for City Council to call on the Government of Ontario to join with the Toronto Police Service and other municipal police services in creating a Provincial/Municipal Auto Theft Task Force to combat this epidemic of auto theft.
